Mines Saint-Etienne 2017 - 2021 Strategic Plan, Building Together!

Summary of Key Projects and Objectives*

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The Strategic Plan for Mines Saint-Etienne is incorporated within the framework of the 5 aims and 4 strategic axes of the Mines-Telecom Institute:

- to constitute an identified, dynamic, open and attractive actor of higher education, at the service of economic and societal developments;
- to construct forms of leadership in key thematic fields at regional, national, European and international levels;
- to be a key player working at the level of the top world technological universities;
- to be a key player, appealing to students and former students, personnel and academic and company partners;
- to be one of the development arms of the policies of the Ministry of Economy, Industry and the Digital Sector, at regional, national and international levels;
- to significantly increase the number of quality students;
- to federate research teams serving the needs of the economy and society;
- to be at the forefront of innovation and support for economic development;
- to internationalise our activities and develop overseas presence.



The School's mission is naturally to contribute through its actions and organisation to this global strategy, to diffuse and to enrich it by means of its high level specialisations.

The strategic axes of the School for the 2017-21 period are defined within the framework of its 4 attributed missions: education and training, research and technology transfer, support to economic development and to scientific, technical and industrial culture.

The Mines Saint-Etienne 2017-21: Building Together ! Strategic Plan defines two strategic axes and a transversal approach to promote the quantitative and qualitative nature of the response to key stakeholders of the School's activities.

• **Strategic axis -1:**

To design and plan together differentiated courses to prepare each and every one for his/her particular specialisation;

• **Strategic axis -2:**

To respond to the issues of industrial transition for all types of enterprise, making Mines Saint-Etienne a laboratory and a key player in the industry of the future;

• **Transversal approach:**

To mobilise teams to reinforce the positioning of Mines Saint-Etienne.



Focus on two major key projects, incorporating strategic axes 1 and 2, and a key project for the transversal approach:

• **Mines Saint-Etienne Tech**

To introduce innovative teaching methods with the LCube and TEAM @ Mines Saint-Etienne, on each of the School campuses, with Mines Saint-Etienne Tech combining an industrial platform with the entrepreneurial sector.

Mines Saint-Etienne Tech will focus on issues relating to industries of the future (manufacturing, healthcare, regional territories, the internet of things) integrating elements of corporate social and environmental responsibility, design and the digital economy.

The aim is to provide a comprehensive package, from initial and professional training to support for enterprises in their industrial transition.

This offer will be connected to the platform network of the Mines-Telecom Institute to ensure clarity and visibility at both regional and national levels.

• **Certificate for Quality in Internationalisation**

Obtaining the Certificate for Quality in Internationalisation from the European Consortium for Accreditation will facilitate the transition of all staff and the students towards a process of internationalisation of our campuses. The task will involve all sectors of the School linked to Engineering education and will be coordinated with the "Commission des Titres d'Ingénieurs". The international activity of our education and research centres will be reaffirmed and reinforced.

Mobilising teams to reinforce the positioning of Mines Saint-Étienne

Organising mutual development by implementing an approach of quality combined with social and environmental responsibility. Such an approach will allow the School, composed of new generation campuses (animated and connected working and living spaces), to function in synergy, where each and every one will think and act in the general interest of the School and its spread of influence. Each campus will focus on a particular specialisation contributing to the collective whole, in a transversal approach of mutual responsibility and subsidiarity, taking into account the commitment of one and all.
