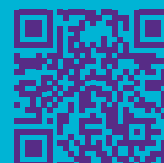

STUDENT VISA APPLICATION

EU CITIZENS: no visa required (valid passport or ID card)

NON-EU CITIZENS: 2 types of visas:

- > short-stay student visa for stays under 90 days
- > long-stay student visa for stays exceeding 90 days

Application procedure subject to country of origin: please contact the French embassy or consulate in your home country and the local Campus France Office when relevant for the academic interview prior to the visa application.

FEES

Full exemption of registration fees for exchange students coming under the framework of a bilateral or Erasmus agreement.

National student contribution: around €105, except for students with exemption on means-based criteria, refugees, or in the case of bilateral agreements with tuition fees waived. For Degree seeking students, applicable fees are subject to the agreement with your home university. Amounts are always clearly mentioned in official letters of admission. Integration activities fees: €25

LIVING EXPENSES

Approximately €800/month, including local transport, food and housing. State housing benefit for all EU students. State housing benefit for non-EU students who hold a long stay visa with "OFII" mention and a means-tested scholarship from their home country.

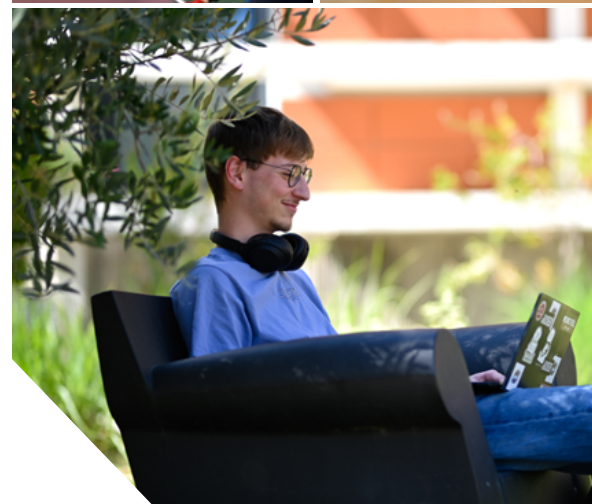
INSURANCE

French Health Insurance is free for international students. International students have to register online by themselves as soon as they have processed their administrative registration at Mines Saint-Étienne.

CIVIL LIABILITY: Mandatory, approximately €15 to be paid at Mines Saint-Étienne.
